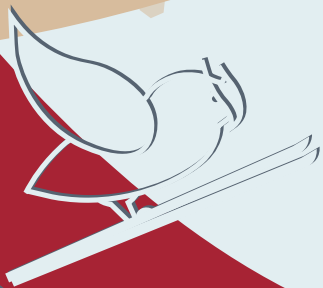

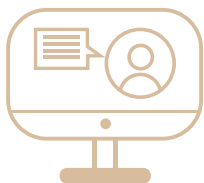

The competition committee reserves the right to change the session of the submitted presentation topic.

Deadline for paper submission: **April 30, 23:59**



Requirements for paper formatting

- General requirements for paper formatting are given in **Appendix 1**.
- References list is drawn up in accordance with **Appendix 2** 'Examples of formatting References'.
- The paper must be formatted in accordance with **Appendix 3** 'Example of paper formatting'.
- **Please note that** the authors are responsible for the originality of the papers submitted for publication, accuracy of the facts, statistical data, last names and initials, references and other information.
- The originality of the text must be **at least 70%** (excluding the references).
- The paper must not have been previously published, and must not have been submitted for consideration and publication in another journal.
- The organizers reserve the right to reject materials that do not meet the requirements for paper formatting.
- The conference proceedings will be posted **in the RSCI database** (<http://elibrary.ru>)

Citations arrangements

Reference list should contain **5-10 citations**. It is recommended to use references to sources **no older than 10 years**. You must state DOI if there is any. Dissertations and abstracts can't be used as references. Source is listed in the text in brackets [1], [2], [3-5], or [4, 6-8]. Reference links must be in a quotation order, **not an alphabetical, despite the language of a citation**. Each source starts with a new line. All the documents mentioned in text, must be included to a reference list. Author(s) respond(s) for data reliability.

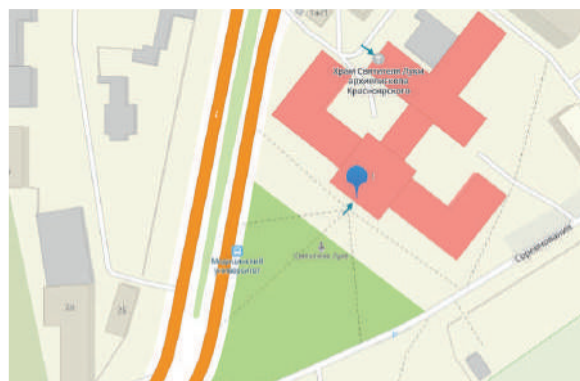
